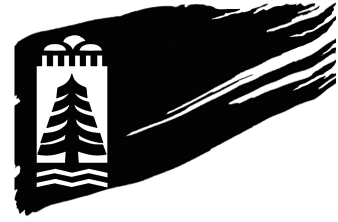

Week 1 (June 4th- 8th)

- AM Outer Space Art** *Elizabeth Brosha* Blast off on an exciting space adventure as we create string art constellations, shimmering shooting stars, watercolor nebulas, planetary paper collages, and glittering Earth Globes.
- AM Star Wars Creations** *Jacob Spill* Get ready for a week of fun projects including light sabers and other crafts from a galaxy far, far away. Perfect for all Jedi and Sith in training!
- PM Zoiks! It's Zombies!** *Jacob Spill* Don't fear the Walking Dead - JOIN 'EM! We'll explore the lighter side of zombies with zombie-themed projects and make a short film about the misunderstood zombies. Don't worry parents, gun crafts not allowed! Think more Plants vs. Zombies.
- PM Arts and Crafts Inspired by India** *Ellen Mancini* Discover the unique style of Indian Artwork. Explore mandalas, henna designs, and dyed rice designs. Have fun with a variety of materials to make monkeys, elephants, and peacocks.

Week 2 (June 11th- 15th)

- AM Rousseau Rain Forest** *Elizabeth Brosha* Explore the rain forest as we study the art of French painter Henri Rousseau. Learn about the layers of the rainforest as we create textured tree frogs, watercolor chameleons, collage birds, rainbow butterflies, tropical tigers and a terrarium in a jar.
- AM Be Your Own Hero** *Jacob Spill* Don't wait around for Superman to save the day – you're going to make your own comic! This is for the hero in all of us! We'll get into comic illustration as well as a variety of superhero-themed projects.
- PM Robots and Aliens** *Britton Donharl* Imagine your ideal robot or alien! We'll draw them, construct them, and put on the details. Be ready to create your wildest outer space fantasies!
- PM Kids Paint Party** *Susanne Harrison* Paint all week! We will be painting with watercolor paints, tempera paints, acrylic paints and pastels on surfaces of all shapes and sizes.

Week 3 (June 18th- 22nd)

- AM Pop Art** *Livy Snyder* Study the evolution of Pop art throughout the Modern Art Movement. Students will bring in a can of their own that they will depict in different mediums, collage a photograph of their choosing, and explore advertisements as art while creating brand names.
- AM Paint Explosion** *Jacob Spill* Learn to paint just like the old masters – HA! Yeah right!! This is about getting messy and exploring with paint! Don't wear your favorite T-shirt to this class.
- PM Splat!** *Britton Donharl* What happens when paint does its own thing? Experiment with paint through dripping, squishing, printing, mixing and swirling. This is a class that will likely get messy!
- PM Face Paint and Temporary Tattoos** *Jacob Spill* Students will learn designs and techniques for face painting each other and themselves! They will also practice drawing on each other's and their own hands and arms with nontoxic temporary ink pens.

Week 4 (June 25th- 29th)

- AM Wearable Art** *Delores Daniels* Stars and Stripes are the theme as we learn to bead and paint a t-shirt. Then learn to paint your favorite jeans, make a macramé belt and keychain, and finish with beading necklaces and bracelets!
- AM Exploring Place through Art** *Jennifer Martz* Students will begin exploring places and geography through art. Each day, we will focus on a different region with crafts related to the area.
- PM Animal Symbolism** *Heather Beemer* Explore culture and history with us as we make art based on Native American and Egyptian stories and myths!
- PM Animals Make Art Too!** *Holly Aiken* Animals come in all kinds of patterns, colors, shapes, sizes, and textures. This week, we will be exploring everything that makes animals unique and how they make the world a more exciting place using everything from paints to fabric to clay.

Week 5 (July 2nd - 6th NO CLASS WEDNESDAY)

- AM Arts of Africa** *Trey Pereyra* Immerse yourself in the culture of Africa! Discover various forms of color and art as we move through the wild lands of Africa, listening to the beating of drums as you dance and tell stories by firelight.
- PM Under the Sea** *Trey Pereyra* Time to go deep-sea fishing. Let us travel to the deepest corners of the ocean. From the crystal clear waters of the coral reef to the darkest corners of the sharks sea, come swim together in this class through the deep blue sea.

Week 6 (July 9th - 13th)

- AM Snippets of Modern Art** *Livy Snyder* Students will create an artwork a day inspired by the different movements in Modern art; including, Dada, Constructivism, and Abstract Expressionism.
- AM Recycle, Repurpose, Reuse** *Delores Daniels* Use the three R's as we make bug houses, bird feeders, toy houses, treasure chests, books, and beads out of recyclable materials!
- PM A Study of Trees** *Ellen Mancini* Embrace nature to create trees from a variety of materials. Experiment with paint, collage, and sculpture that reflect the wonder of trees.
- PM Dia de los Muertos – Sugar Skulls** *Susanne Harrison* Create a sugar skull mask, a papier mache skull, skull painting, skull garland and more.

Week 7 (July 16th - 20th)

- AM Let's Explore the Rainforest!** *Shelly Doyle* In this class we will explore the plants and animals that live in the Rainforest. We will do projects about the animals and use the colors of all the tropical birds.
- AM Ships Ahoy!** *Mary Grace* Sail the summer away with boat craft fun!
- PM Let's Celebrate Pusheen!** *Stephanie Rittner* Pusheen is everyone's favorite donut loving cat from Japan. Let's turn Pusheen into artwork... we will draw, paint, papier-mache, and sew Pusheen and some of his favorite things.
- PM Learning Art through Science** *Holly Aiken* If you think science is boring, I'm here to change your mind! We are going to paint without using brushes, make rainbows without rain, and even levitate objects!

Week 8 (July 23rd - 27th)

- AM Everything Garden** *Mary Grace* - Let's turn our gaze to the garden. Join us in creating colorful works of art as we are inspired by nature.
- AM Chemistry and Art** *Delores Daniels* Combine science and art as we use household items to create a Universe in a Jar, lava lamps, 3-D paintings, p dough, and slime, slime, SLIME!
- PM Exploring the Senses** *Holly Aiken* By the end of this week, you will have artwork you can smell, hear, touch, see, and taste.
- PM Architectural Adventures** *Liz Martineau* Explore our local place, from the Romero Cabin to Mesa Public Library. Each day we will walk to a nearby building to connect with the local architecture. We will use what we learn about materials, form, and function to design our own spaces.

Week 9 (July 30th – August 3rd)

- AM Discover Disney** *Trey Pereyra* Discover the magic of Disney. Start at the beginning with our favorite mouse as we walk through history and art to present day Disney. Learn about making our favorite Disney characters and maybe just create a few of our own!
- AM Under the Sea** *Shelly Doyle* In this class we will learn all about the creatures that live in the vast ocean! We will do projects incorporating all the pieces of the sea: fish, dolphins, sharks, seashells and more!
- PM I Like to Move It!** *Jasmine Torres* This class offers a week of varying dance and movement styles. Each day we will focus on a different style of dance, teaching technique, fun combinations, and of course, a love of movement.
- PM Bugs, Bugs, Everywhere!** *Holly Aiken* What is more exciting than spending a whole week learning about the world of bugs? So many bugs, so little time! Play-dough, paint, water, and so much more.
