9/10: **Cupcake Factory** (Elizabeth Brosha): What can you do with paper and glue? Inspired by the story: "If You Give a Cat a Cupcake", children will use construction paper, scissors and glue to create colorful paper cupcakes.

9/24: **Cut Paper Monsters** (Elizabeth Brosha): Inspired by Ed Emberley's art, monsters don't have to be scary! Children will tear, cut and glue a colorful monster collage. We will read the stories: "Glad Monster, Sad Monster" and "If You're a Monster and You Know It" as inspiration for our monster friends.

10/15: **Flower Garden** (Elizabeth Brosha): An open-ended invitation to create a beautiful garden using colorful paper shapes, stamps, and paint! Learn collage techniques perfect for little fingers!

10/29: **Fish Eyes** (Elizabeth Brosha): Design a paper fish with neon colors and circle stickers. Create a collage by painting an underwater scene where your fish lives with his friends. Read and count with the story "Fish Eyes" by Lois Ehlert.

11/12: **Monoprints** (Elizabeth Brosha): Children will learn how to make and pull unique prints using tempera paint, brayers, rollers, and cotton swabs. This colorful process art produces beautiful, magical, and surprising art pieces worthy of framing.

11/26: **Robo Lab** (Elizabeth Brosha): Use shiny paper and scraps to create robots in all shapes, sizes, and colors! Paint, glue and color a helpful, friendly robot!

12/10: **Mouse Paints** (Elizabeth Brosha): Children will experiment with paint as we read the colorful story "Mouse Paint" by Ellen Walsh. This amazing story shows us that primary colors when mixed together make secondary colors. Children will enjoy mixing and painting with red, yellow, and blue as we go on a paint adventure with mouse!
