## 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> Grade

8/28: Beaded Art and Accessories (Jenn Moss): Students will learn beading techniques and create their own unique products

9/4/19: Introduction to Ukulele and Guitar (Matt Prather): Students will get a chance to learn some Ukulele and Guitar as an introduction to a 10-week course offered to learn over the semester. The second half of the class will be an Art and Music appreciation class and allow students to talk about what they learned and felt.

9/11: Viking Ships (Ellen Mancini): take a look at history and learn about the way Vikings made their sailing vessels to resemble a dragon. Use a shoebox as a base, add heavy cardboard and paint to construct your own Viking ship.

9/18: Optical Illusion Block (Susanne Harrison): Create your own group of optical illusions with sharpies and turn the collection into a cube.

9/25: Colorful Spiderwebs (Ellen Mancini): Embrace the complexity of the woven web. Learn to draw a gigantic web shape to adorn with watercolor paint abstractions.

10/2: Papier Mache Monsters Part 1 (Susanne Harrison): Part 1 Create your own papier mache monster. Happy or creepy... you choose. **PLEASE NOTE: Because this is a 2-part class, you must sign up for both part I on October 2nd and part II on October 9th.**

10/9: Papier Mache Monsters Part 2 (Susanne Harrison): Part 2 Paint and decorate your monster in bold fun colors and textures. **PLEASE NOTE: Because this is a 2-part class, you must sign up for both part I on October 2nd and part II on October 9th.**

10/16: Van Gogh Sunflowers (Ellen Mancini): Appreciate one of Van Gogh's most famous paintings. Work with oil pastel on black paper for a bright and colorful effect.

10/23: Color Your Jungle (Dee Homans): Who lives and what grows in your jungle? Draw and paint jungle scenes.

### **Conference Week: October 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>: 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Grade**

10/24: AM Mixed Media Collage (Alejandra Celada Spillari): Collect a variety of materials to work with. Draw a landscape using the different textures and paste into a newspaper as a background

10/24: PM Misty Mountain Painting (Ellen Mancini): Become inspired by our local landscape. Use sponge paint to create layers of color while learning about dark and light shading.

### **Conference Week: October 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>: 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Grade (Continued)**

**For Conference week we are combining grades 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>.**

10/25: AM Bird Mobiles (Daisy Gorman-Nichols): Use your imagination to make these beautiful birds take flight.

10/25: PM Bright Sun Wall Hanging (Ellen Mancini): Start with a large heavy paper plate, cut out poster board to make sun ray shapes. Cut out and fold features to glue on. Finish off with bright color paints.

**Conference Week: October 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>: 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade**  
**For Conference week we are combining grades 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>**

10/24: AM Leaf Printing (Daisy Gorman-Nichols): Use Nature to create a special piece of art.

10/24: PM Elephant Pack (Susanne Harrison): Learn to draw elephants from many angles and paint an elephant pack silhouette style.

10/25: AM Perspective Pumpkin Patch (Elizabeth Brosha): Make a one-point perspective to show foreground, middle, and background Use a fall pumpkin patch for inspiration.

10/25: PM Pumpkin Painting and Halloween Slime (Susanne Harrison): Paint a textured painting on canvas board using hot glue, paint and salt. Then make slime!

10/30: Beach Diorama (Ellen Mancini): Imagine yourself on a sandy beach along the ocean. Glue shells, stones, sand, glass fragments, and tissue paper to have a 3-D effect on the inside of a box.

11/6: Cats! Cats! Cats! (Elizabeth Brosha): Make cute and colorful cat sculptures out of recycled materials.

11/13: Pirate Ships (Dee Homans): Make a pirate ship from wood and pretend you're on the high seas.

11/20: Thankfulness Tree for the Family (Alejandra Celada Spillari): Brainstorm about the importance of Thanksgiving. Using a quilling technique, design a tree trunk, then cut out leaves from scrapbook or color paper. Write on each leaf reasons for being grateful. Take extra leaves home so other family members can write their own thanks.

12/4: Shadow Puppets (Dee Homans) Make shadow puppets and put on some short skits.

12/11: "Gingerbread" Houses (Dee Homans) Edible art from graham crackers and you-know-what as decorations.
