8/28: Introduction to Ukulele and Guitar (Matt Prather): Students will get a chance to learn some Ukulele and Guitar as an introduction to a 10-week course offered to learn over the semester. The second half of the class will be an Art and Music appreciation class and allow students to talk about what they learned and felt.

9/4: Fearless Footwear Part 1 (Dee Homans): Sculpt a shoe from self-hardening clay. Bring the most eye-catching shoe or boot or slipper you can find and sculpt it from self-hardening clay. **PLEASE NOTE: Because this is a 2-part class, you must sign up for both part 1 on September 4th and Part 2 on September 11th**

9/11: Fearless Footwear Part 2 (Dee Homans): Paint and decorate your sculpture. **PLEASE NOTE: Because this is a 2-part class, you must sign up for both part 1 on September 4th and part 2 on September 11th.**

9/18: African Animals with Kente Cloth Texture (Ellen Mancini)” Learn about the patterns, colors, and textures of African Kente Cloth. Draw the outline of your favorite African Animal and use markers to design Kente cloth patterns to decorate the animal. Add a background with African imagery as well.

9/25: Succulent Garden (Elizabeth Brosha): Use line art and patterns to create a Southwest watercolor painting of succulents and cacti.

10/2: Intro to Printmaking (Ellen Mancini): Become familiar with different printing possibilities and basic tools. Experiment with printing sponge shapes in colors on paper. Cut out foam shapes to ink and print in an overlapping fashion on a solid background that result in unique textures. Make a line drawing on thin Styrofoam sheets to print as well.

10/9: Surrealistic Dream Dolls (Ellen Mancini): Observe the work of Salvador Dali and discuss Surrealism. Draw yourself from head to toe and cut out like a paper doll. Use your imagination to draw a scene with objects and characters from a dream of or a story. Finally, paste yourself into the dream.

10/16: Papier Mache Monsters Part 1 (Susanne Harrison): Part 1 Create your own papier mache monster. Happy or creepy... you choose. **PLEASE NOTE: Because this is a 2-part class, you must sign up for both part I on October 16th and part II on October 23rd.**

10/23: Papier Mache Monsters Part 2 (Susanne Harrison) Part 2 Paint and decorate your monster in bold fun colors and textures. **PLEASE NOTE: Because this is a 2-part class, you must sign up for both part I on October 16th and part II on October 23rd.**

Conference Week: October 24th and 25th: 4th-6th Grade **For Conference week we are combining grades 4th, 5th, 6th**

10/24: AM Leaf Printing (Daisy Gorman-Nichols): Use Nature to create a special piece of art.

10/24: PM Elephant Pack (Susanne Harrison): Learn to draw elephants from many angles and paint an elephant pack silhouette style.

10/25: AM Perspective Pumpkin Patch (Elizabeth Brosha): Make a one-point perspective to show foreground, middle, and background Use a fall pumpkin patch for inspiration.

10/25: PM Pumpkin Painting and Halloween Slime (Susanne Harrison): Paint a textured painting on canvas board using hot glue, paint and salt. Then make slime!

10/30: Soft Sculpture Portraits (Dee Homans): Sew and stuff a fabric head and bust and turn it into a squishy portrait of someone you know.

11/6: Optical Illusion Block (Susanne Harrison): Create your own group of optical illusions with sharpies and turn the collection into a cube.

11/13: Elephant Mixed Media Mosaics (Elizabeth Brosha): Use stencils, scrap papers, and paint to create a painted mosaic of a colorful elephant.

11/20: Radial Art Name Mandalas (Susanne Harrison): Create a beautiful radial symmetry name mandala using pencils, sharpies, and paint.

12/4: City Scapes (Daisy Gorman-Nichols) The sky is the limit in this class. Create a scene of your favorite city.

12/11: Eiffel Tower (Ellen Mancini): In a step by step process, using a ruler and pencil, learn to do a line drawing of the wonder of Paris, France. Use a black marker to enhance the complex line patterns and add watercolor paint.
